The Mayor and Council of the Town of Manchester met on the above date. Those present were Mayor Warner, Tammy Black, Debra Howe, Steve Miller, Chief Hess, Kelly Baldwin and Natalie Singer.

There was no quorum.

Mayor Warner announced that MVHS Stampede will be held on Wednesday, September 3, 2014. Mayor Warner thanked all those who supported the first "National Night Out" held on August 5, 2014. This was a great event and will be a nice addition to the Town's calendar.

Mr. Miller gave the monthly Town Administration and Public Works report. The Town received money from MEA for programmable thermostats and heat replacement. The Town has been awarded a Civil War Heritage Trails Grant for \$48,000 to install ADA improvements for this building. The interior design of the new Town Hall is complete. We have contracted with a geo-tech firm for borings and soil analysis. Demolition should take place in the next month. Code enforcement continues.

Chief Hess read the monthly police report. There were 68 calls for service in July with 13 arrests. Chief Hess also thanked those involved with the National Night Out Traffic problems persist on York Street.

Council members gave committee reports.

Ms. Black made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Howe seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned after 7:56pm.
