THEFT PREVENTION

- **Recently our Town along the Main Street corridor and our Whispering Valley Community experienced several thefts involving the entering of UNLOCKED vehicles. One incident involved stolen bikes.**
- **We continue to have low crime numbers in our Town due to community partnership and communication.**
- **Please remember to lock all doors and take time to remind your neighbors. Keep exterior lights on.**
- **Always roll up the windows and lock your vehicle, even if it's in front of your home.**
- **Never leave valuables in plain view, even if your vehicle is locked. Place them in the trunk or at least out of sight.**
- **Remove portable electronic devices such as smart phones, including their mounts if possible. Never leave guns in your vehicles, it is not a good practice and you are responsible for your firearms.**
- **Most importantly, please continue to Report suspicious persons and activity.**
